I'm pleased to share the July edition of our St. Jude's Elder Care newsletter. As summer reached its peak, our homes were filled with joy, connection, and celebration.




With two birthdays on 7/7 and two more on 7/21, it's a month of double dates—maybe a sign to play the lotto or try our luck at blackjack!
